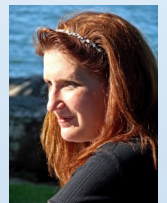

As a family, friend or carer of a person being supported by Ormerod we want to know what you think about our service and about anything we can be doing better.

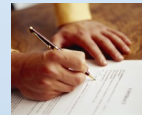
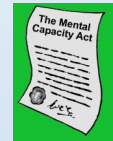
One of the ways we do this is by having a family, friend and carer forum that meets regularly.
